



Free Lent Devotionals Available beginning Sunday, March 3 Ash Wednesday on March 6 will begin the Christian season of Lent, which is a time of introspection as we journey to Jerusalem and the cross with Jesus. <u>The Sanctuary for Lent</u> contains brief readings for each day of the season. Daily scriptures, devotions and prayers consider the dimensions of Christian discipleship that lead us into deeper relationship with Christ and our hurting world.
