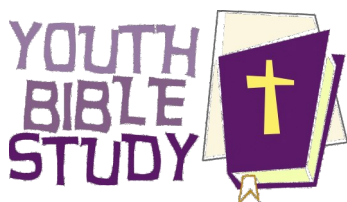
Hey, Kids!

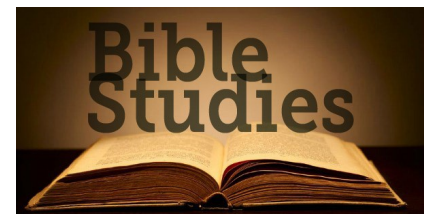
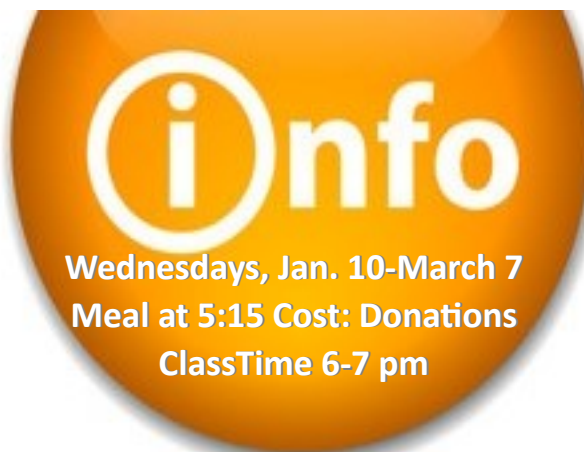


Youth Bible Study
