# **Church Raising Funds For Additional Parking Lot**

Can you guess how many parking spaces the church currently has? The answer is 155. Additionally, we will lose another nine spaces in order to provide space for a driveway back to the Circle of Care homes. With this in mind, the Trustees, in conjunction with the Finance Committee and Administrative Council, have affirmed a plan to build 32 additional parking places to the West of the current building. The cost to build this lot will be between \$25,000-\$30,000. We will not build until we have raised the necessary funds. To date we have raised \$6,500.00.
